RELEVANT INFORMATION CONCERNING COVID-19 IN SALINAS

Following the plan and protocol drawn up by this Town Council with regard to the prevention and detection of COVID-19 in Salinas, today we received information from the Health Authorities about the impact of the virus in the municipality of Salinas.

There are currently 6 active cases of COVID-19 in our municipality. These cases <u>are</u> <u>fully controlled, being monitored by the Health Authorities and under quarantine</u>. According to the information received by this Town Hall, from the Health Authorities, all the protocols are being applied and possible cases that could arise are being traced, but to date the possible related cases have turned out to be negative.

From this Town Council **we would like to thank the information received from the Health Authorities**, and above all we would like to thank those affected, because we were informed about the situation from the first moment. **This has helped us to be able to coordinate the work** with the Health Authorities much better and to apply the different protocols and means established to date, in the most efficient way possible.

In the next few days **tests and analyses will be carried out on our town's sewerage system**, in order **to quantify the incidence of the virus by area and the viral load of the same**, in accordance with the frequency of sampling recommended to us by the Health Authorities.

Public Health authorities **send us a message of tranquillity** and patience, as the situation is under control and they indicate that, for the moment, **it is not necessary to apply extraordinary measures in our municipality, as long as the situation does not change.**

Our Public Health department send us a message of prudence and responsibility, strongly complying with all the rules and restrictions established to date. It is heavily recommended that we avoid as much as possible unnecessary social gatherings and travel, considering the delicate situation in some of the surrounding towns and cities.

Remember that in case you experience any symptom (fever, diarrhea, lack of taste or smell, persistent dry cough or breathing difficulty) you must contact the Health Authorities through the Health Center of Sax (966 957 000) or through the Generalitat Valenciana's phone number 900 300 555.
